For every day you complete an **Individual** action, place a **red** sticker on that day, for every **faith community or church wide** action, use a **blue** sticker for every **regional or ISAIAH-wide** action, use a **green** sticker.

Individual Commitments:

1. Tweet
 - Tweet your 100-day commitment
 - Use the hashtag #ISAIAH100
 - Tweet action alerts
 - Tweet at your public officials
2. Social Media
 - Go to a training on how to use different social media outlets
 - Share Facebook post or retweet a post using #ISAIAH100
 - Read an article that is shared on social media
3. Read & Research an issue
 - Read from the suggested bibliography (in development)
 - Attend a lecture or informational event
4. Pray
 - Use the Prayer devotional card to lead a prayer
 - Call a friend to pray with you
5. Public Officials
 - Call your public official
 - Draft a letter or email to your public officials
6. Share your story
 - In a testimony at a hearing

- At a forum in your church
 - With your Priest/Pastor
 - With two people in your congregation or community
 - Write a “Letter to the Editor” in your local newspaper
7. Courageous Conversations
 - With your clergy
 - With your legislator
 - With two people that don’t have your same point of view
 8. Join Webinar
 - About Sanctuary
 - About Health Care
 - Prison expansion/over policing
 - An issue you need to learn about
 9. Talk to/Meet with your Pastor/Priest
 - About Sanctuary
 - About getting involved if your church is not involved
 - About your own story
 - Ask them to preach about an issue
 10. Make a financial contribution to ISAIAH
 11. Research other action groups Nationally and Minnesota based
 - Join an action or presentation held by another organization
 - Research other groups perspective on current events
 12. Phone Calls
 - Call 2 friends to join the 100-day action
 - Call a friend to initiate state calls to their public officials
 - Call a friend in another part of the state to call their representatives
 - Conduct a prayer chain through a phone bank

Faith Community:

1. Host a Forum/Training
 - About an issue you need to learn about or want your community to understand
 - Work with your organizers to develop a training
 - Read a book together and hold a book meeting
 - Host a social media training

- Host a series of House Meetings
 - Host a Know Your Rights training
 - Conduct a 1:1 training in your church
 - Host a movie night & discussion
2. Faith
 - Host a prayer circle
 - Lead a prayer circle outside of a public official’s office
 - Develop your theological grounding of current issues
 3. Take Action
 - Circulate a petition
 - Attend a Town Hall Meeting
 - Attend your city’s Caucuses in the Spring
 - Have a Letter to the Editor writing session
 - Circulate postcards
 - Meet with the public officials that represent your congregation
 - Become a sanctuary or sanctuary supporting congregation
 - Go to a hearing at the Capitol
 4. Community
 - Talk with people in your church to make a financial contribution
 - Conduct a survey in your church to understand what people are facing
 - Outreach to the neighborhood around your church – invite to an event

Regional Action:

1. Attend a direct action
2. Attend regional trainings and meetings
3. Attend four central actions throughout the 100 days
4. Attend vigil
5. Speak at Action

3. April 6th – Turning over the tables action
4. May 4 – giant prophetic action (close of 100 Days)
